



CEI Concurrent Enrollment Consent Form

CEI courses are \$75.00/Credit

Please read and acknowledge the following information. Both parent and student must initial below.

1. If these classes are paid by Advanced Opportunities Funding:

		A failing score will result in the student paying out of pocket for the next class including IDLA, college classes, dual enrollment, AP classes, and CTE programs.
		If your student fails a course, they must take, pay for and pass another class before they are allowed to access Advanced Opportunity funds again.
		If your student fails a class paid for by Advanced Opportunities funds and the next class they take is a college course, they must pay for and pass the ENTIRE TERM.
		Scores must be posted on transcript per the State of Idaho. You cannot opt out of this if you fail the class or receive a grade lower than desired.
		Funds must be requested before the class starts.
		Funds for summer classes must be requested before summer break.
		Student must have a State of Idaho Advanced Opportunities form signed on file.

2. If you are paying for the class out of pocket:

		Students have the option to have their scores posted on their high school transcript.
		Funds must be paid to CEI by the registration fee deadline.

3. Grade Implications:

		Grades earned will count toward the student's overall college GPA.
		Poor or failing grades may negatively impact future financial aid, including scholarship opportunities, as well as limit admission opportunities to other institutions.
		Students enrolling at a college or university other than CEI will need to transfer their CEI credits. It is illegal to withhold college transcripts when transferring between institutions.
		It is the student's responsibility to check with the receiving institution on transferring Concurrent Enrollment credits.

4. Other:

		Students must provide their own transportation to and from CEI.
		Alturas Preparatory Academy, not CEI, will determine if Concurrent Enrollment courses satisfy high school graduation requirements. Therefore, your student agrees to meet with his/her academic advisor each semester.
		Your student is responsible for registering, dropping, adding, and withdrawing from courses according to CEI's deadlines. Failure to meet deadlines may result in your student being dropped from classes or owing tuition fees for classes they did not drop.
		I acknowledge and confirm that my student is academically, socially, and emotionally prepared and capable to succeed in a college environment.
